New Bio Security Procedures

We are taking bio-security very seriously. To help insure the health and well being of your fish we are making several changes. The most notable are listed below.

Each koi tank is required to have its own koi net. The show will not provide nets nor provide net sanitization. If two or more tanks wish to share the same net, then the tanks must be adjacent to each other and the splash shield will be removed from between those tanks. (The following local dealers are offering special pricing on koi nets for the show: Still Water Gardens, Koi Gardens and Blue Iris Water Gardens.)

We are installing new splash shields which we believe will be very effective in preventing cross contamination between show tanks.

We will have new net holders which will require that the nets themselves be placed below the splash shields with only the handles above.

We will have updated sanitization procedures for all fish handlers and equipment.

PREPARING YOUR FISH FOR THE SHOW

Take only healthy fish to the show! Treat fish with problems and leave them at home!

Five to seven days before the show:

- Stop all feeding to purge fish.
- Pan each fish.
- Examine each fish including belly and gills.
- Take two pictures or more of each fish.
- Measure each fish.
- If needed, place fish in a clean, algae-free isolation tank to purge fish.

TRANSPORTING YOUR FISH TO THE SHOW

Equipment needed:

- Clear, sturdy plastic bags.
- Rubber bands, 3/8" size.
- Sturdy cardboard boxes with bottoms well-sealed or coolers.
- Ammonia neutralizer.
- Optional: ice packs, oxygen for filling bags, other medications & mild tranquilizers.

Bagging your fish:

- Use double, or even triple, bags in case one leaks.
- In the bag have enough water to cover the koi's gill plates. Air/oxygen is more important than excess water and lighter too.
- Larger koi, over 24" should be in individual bags.
- Smaller koi, two per bag as they travel better with a buddy.
- Add ammonia neutralizer and other medications per your personal preferences.
- Add oxygen, or, for short durations of less than an hour, lots of air. Do not exhale into the bag as your expired air contains too little oxygen.
- Wrap bags securely with rubber bands to make water tight seals.
- Add optional ice pack, well wrapped in newspaper, to bottom of box.
- Place bags in boxes with pointed corners of bag lying horizontal, not vertical.

Transporting:

- Place boxes across the vehicle so fish are pointed towards the side of the vehicle, not towards the front or back of the vehicle. The boxes should preferably be between the rear wheel wells. By doing this, during light acceleration and stopping the fish will roll gently with the curvature of the bag. Be gentle going around corners so as to not bang nose or tails into boxes.

SHOW ETIQUETTE

- During judging, please refrain from all communications, verbal & emotional, with our Judges. (After the judging is over, the judges will be happy to discuss their decisions with you.)
- Respect the decisions of the Judges.
- Keep all food, beverages and tobacco out of the show areas.
- Do not feed the fish or put anything into the tanks.
- Keep your hands out of the tanks.
- Do not tap sides of tanks
- Do not remove air stones, handle nets or handle panning tubs.
- Respect the feelings of your fellow hobbyist.
- Explain the above etiquette to general public as needed.

KOI & GOLDFISH SHOW RULES AND INFORMATION

General Conditions:

Show will be English Style. Each entrant will have his or her own tank. By mutual consent, entrants may share tanks. This show is open to all fish hobbyists and the hobbyist must own the fish. Fish vendors are prohibited from entry. Within reason, fish vendors' children are allowed to enter. At discretion of the Show Chairperson and/or Judges, categories may be combined depending upon number of fish entered in the category or in the show.

1. Judges may reclassify any fish to another category or size.
2. The show chairperson and/or the judges as appropriate shall decide any questions or disputes.
3. We have a 16 six foot and 4 eight foot koi show tanks. We are encouraging a maximum of koi, in inches, per tank and as many participants as possible.
4. We have 13 ten gallon and 7 twenty gallon goldfish aquariums.
5. To reserve a tank:
 - Complete the application, enclose appropriate fees and mail ASAP.

For Koi tanks:

- With 50 fish points, (see application), tanks will be reserved on a first-come basis for entries received by August 4th
- With less than 50 fish points, remaining tanks will be assigned giving priority to those with the most fish points.

For Goldfish aquariums:

- With four goldfish under 3" or three goldfish over 3", tanks will be reserved on a first-come basis for entries received by August 4th
- With less than the above, tanks will be reserved giving priority to the most fish.
- Any tanks or aquariums remaining after August 4th will be then be assigned in the order entries are received up until 8:30 am, Saturday, August 16th.
- Size of the assigned tanks and aquariums will be determined by the show chairs and will be based on fish loads.
- If two or more fish owners wish to reserve a tank together, all of those sharing the tank must sign a mutual consent form to be attached to their entry forms. The entry forms must be submitted together.
- Each koi tank must have its own net. If two tanks are sharing a single net, then the tanks must be adjacent and the splash shield between them removed.

Equipment provided by the club:

1. Show tanks with net cover, air supply and air stone.
2. Panning tub (22").
3. Aquariums with air supply and air stone.
4. Oxygen at check out.

Fish check in:

1. Friday, August 15th, 3:00 pm to dusk and Saturday, September 16th, 7:00 am to 8:30 am.
2. Please complete the fish entry form for each fish entered prior to check in. Enclose two pictures of each koi. Goldfish pictures are recommended but not required.
3. The fish benching committee will examine each fish at check in. Unhealthy fish will be rejected. Fish will be measured and may be reclassified as determined by the benching committee or judges.
4. Float your fish in their bags in your assigned tank or aquarium until the benching committee has examined them.
5. Benching committee will release fish into the tank or aquarium.
6. Entrants must remain until their fish are released into the assigned tank or aquarium.
7. Fish are to remain on exhibit until check out time. Entrants who remove their fish early face disqualification.
8. All reasonable and prudent care will be taken by the club to safeguard the fish. **NO ONE IS TO HANDLE, FEED, CLEAN, ADJUST OR CHANGE THE ENVIROMENT OF THE FISH** except the Show Chairperson or his designees.

Judging:

1. Judges decisions are final
2. **Please refrain from any and all communication with the judges during judging.**

Fish check out:

1. Check out is Sunday from 3:00 pm to 5:00 pm.
2. It shall be the responsibility of those sharing a tank to properly identify and segregate their fish before check out
3. The club will provide oxygen at check out.
4. Entrants are to provide bags, rubber bands and carrying containers.
5. Entrants are responsible to net and bag their own fish.
